**SPEAKER GUIDE ANSWERS:**

1. Two prime goals of RB Neighborhood Watch: A. **Crime Prevention** B. **Emergency Preparedness.**

3. What car is stolen most from RB: **Honda**
4. What communication occurs at the Office of Emergency Services (OES) Command Center that most affects you when a disaster occurs? **Answer would vary. Evacuation shelter locations are communicated to media from this site among other decisions.**
5. During a major disaster, volunteers must take care of first **THEMSELVES**, second **FAMILY OR CO-workers nearby** and if time permits –**NEIGHBORS.**
6. The most important role NHW volunteers have is to assist neighbors to become **INFORMED** and **PREPARED** before disasters occur.
7. Evacuation is a personal choice unless mandated by the **POLICE** Department.
8. The RB Emergency Disaster Alert System, via phone, contacts what NHW leaders when imminent danger is determined? District Coordinators, Area Coordinators and **Home Owner Association Presidents.**
9. A Neighborhood Buddy is not a Block Captain but someone who **YOU CAN RELY ON TO HELP YOU IN SOME WAY.**
10. National Night Out, the first Tuesday in August is a nationally recognized event when people in neighborhoods meet to share **CRIME PREVENTION AWARENESS.**
11. After the Southern California Shake Out event in 2008, some folks in District G, High Country West, organized an After Shock drill. People who participated put a **WHITE CLOTH** or door hanger on their front door knob to indicate they were **OK.**
12. The next California Shake Out Drill is scheduled for October 15, **2009.**
13. Project BE PREPARED—DON'T BE SCARED has focused on helping RB senior citizens **PROTECT THEMSELVES** and their **ASSETS.**

Senior citizens and other “special needs” populations in RB can be assisted by NHW volunteers by: **answers will vary according to ideas shared during breakout sessions however, the ELDERCARE DIRECTORY distributed during the training has many resources helpful to seniors and others needing specialized care.**
